

TAU Racing A CASE STUDY

We undertook a project with TAU (Team Aberdeen University) Racing to assist them with productivity in their workshop. We have been a partner and sponsor of TAU Racing for the last 8 years. Each year a dedicated team of students design, build, market and race a car to compete in the Formula Student competition held at Silverstone.

THE OBJECTIVE for TAU Racing was to help them to utilise the space in their workshop more effectively.

THE RESULTS from working with us and implementing a systematic '5S' approach were;

- > Placing 6th out of 81 teams in the competition
- > Additional testing time as a result of increased efficiency
- Enhanced workshop space
- > Improved safety in their workspaces
- > Decreased frustration

IMPLEMENTING 5S WITH TAU RACING

#01 SORT

We carried out a review of the workshop and equipped the team to carry out a tool audit. This allowed them to identify which tools required replacing due to breakages or disrepair and which tools were not being used that frequently. Items were categorised with red stickers if they needed to be taken out of use or were not required, and green stickers for items most frequently used or acceptable and finally orange stickers for items that needed a repair or service. This allowed for space to be made and de-clutter completed.

#02 SET IN ORDER

Stage Two of the process was to 'Set in Order', which is for the tools and fasteners to be placed/organised in a way that best supports the team in doing their work, e.g. items frequently used are moved closer to the workspace that they are required in, items were clearly labelled and contained using simple tool control systems, colour coded bins or shadow boards.

Due to there being multiple departments within the TAU Racing team each of their tool kits were not only foamed to allow for tool control, but also labelled and each of the tools etched with unique identification markings for quick identification and use of the tool required. The toolkits are ideal mobile storage for all of the events that the team attend, such as Subsea Expo, Silverstone etc. allowing for guick and immediate access to the tools.

This reduced the time taken previously and searching for lost or missing items has been eliminated. Mistakes caused by misplaced items are prevented and accidents are avoided because there is adequate space for all operations. In previous years the team have had to work overtime on the car in their evenings and weekends, but due to the time saved this year the team haven't had to do

this once. All of the marginal gains of time made by the team have allowed them to achieve an extra week of testing on the car which will make all the difference at their annual race at Silverstone.

#03 SHINE

Stage Three of our approach was to advise the team to 'Shine' the area which is essentially a scrub, sweep and straighten of the work area. Work areas that contain contamination such as dust, dirt or oil are prone to cause product defects, equipment and process malfunction, as well as safety hazards to employees.

Stage 3 identifies and removes these items, but also creates means for daily (or more frequent) removal. The 'Shine' stage allows the tools and fasteners to last longer and therefore reduces costs for the team. The changes implemented during this stage impressed the university so much that the principles are now being implemented by other departments.

#04 STANDARDISE

Stage Four allows for a 'Standardising' method to be put in place. Each of the teams has their own toolkit provided by Grampian Fasteners to allow for accountability for the cleanliness and upkeep of their area and equipment or tools. Without a clear standard, there can be no way to ensure accountability, monitor adherence or make improvements.

#05 SUSTAIN

The final stage is to 'Sustain' all of the process. We continue to work with TAU Racing to ensure that further improvements can be identified, made and that they continue to receive the benefits from working with us as Partners in Productivity.
